Judges

Rule 34.6.2.1 - At each affiliated Club Show, at least one registered Judge of any level must adjudicate.

Rule 34.6.2.2 - Unless special permission has been obtained from British Showjumping, in every competition held at an affiliated National Show, at least two registered Judges must adjudicate. One of these two judges may be a Level 1 Judge, however the other judge must be a Level 2 or above Judge.

Rule 34.6.2.3 - The show organising committee shall nominate one Level 2 or above Judge to act as Chairman of the Judges for the duration of the show. The duties of the Chairman of the Judges are to assist and advise the show organising committee on all aspects of Showjumping.

Rule 34.6.2.4 - At least one Level 3 Judge is required to judge the following competitions:

34.6.2.4.1 - Classes of £1000 or over First Prize

34.6.2.4.2 - Second Round Classes or Direct Qualifier Classes which qualify for HOYS or RIHS

34.6.2.4.3 - National Finals organised by British Showjumping Rule 36.6.2.5 - Water Jumps

34.6.2.5.1 - If a water jump is included in the course, a registered Judge of any level must be appointed to judge this obstacle.

34.6.2.5.2 - In a class that requires a Level 3 Judge, if a water jump is used, a Level 2 or Level 3 Judge must officiate at this obstacle.

Rule 34.6.2.6 - Timing

34.6.2.6.1 - The Timekeeper operating the automatic timing equipment must be registered with British Showjumping as a Judge or Timekeeper.

34.6.2.6.2 - In a class that requires a Level 3 Judge, either a Timekeeper, Level 2 or Level 3 Judge must operate the timing equipment.

Course Designers

Rule 36.6.4 - A listed Course Designer must be employed for all affiliated competitions (Rule 34.5)

Rule 36.6.5 - Course Designers are not allowed to ride in a competition for which they have designed the course.

Rule 36.6.6 - The Course Designer is responsible for designing the course, supervising the building of the obstacles (including the practice obstacles) and measuring the course. When the course is ready in all respects he/she must report to the Judge.

Rule 36.6.7 - It is the responsibility of the Judge to inspect the obstacles and to satisfy himself/herself that the course is in accordance with the conditions of the competitions and has been correctly measured. The Judge has the sole responsibility for the conduct of the competition and may direct the Course Designer to make any alterations to the course which he/she considers necessary.

Restrictions - British Showjumping Course Designers can design and build the course for all competitions indicated in the table to the left, plus Special Competitions listed in Section 3 of the Members Handbook with the following restrictions in place: -

Note A - British Showjumping Club Competitions only.

Note B - Adult competitions with £150 first prize or less and Pony competitions with £50 first prize or less.

Note C - Adult competitions (up to & inc 1.40m) with £200 first prize money or less and Pony competitions with £75 first prize money or less.

Note D - Adult or Pony competitions with £1000 first prize money or less.
