

FEI PASSPORTS



1. Please allow at least 30 DAYS FROM THE TIME YOU MAKE YOUR APPLICATION UNTIL YOU HAVE A PASSPORT VALIDATED AND READY FOR FEI COMPETITION.
2. If the horse is jointly owned by 2 or more people, ALL OWNERS must be recorded on the Application form and in the passport. If the horse is owned by a Company, then the Agents responsible for the horse should be shown as well as the company name.
3. The Nationality of the horse is that of it's owner. When a horse belonging to owners of different nationalities acting in partnership, the owners must declare the nationality under which their horse is to compete. The horse in question must retain that nationality until the partnership is dissolved or the horse is sold.
4. The horse/pony's National Passport MUST BE ENCLOSED WITH THIS APPLICATION FORM. A horse/pony must not hold more than one passport.
5. The cost of FEI passports for 2010 are:
 - Horse Passport/Revalidation £175
 - Pony Passport/Revalidation £65
 - Horse/Pony Duplicate £65
 - DEFRA Section 9 Insert £33
 - Express Handling Service (48 hours) £100
6. There will be a charge of £33 to insert a Section 9 into an FEI passport to bring it into line with DEFRA Regulations.
7. There will be a charge of £100 for an FEI passport which requires stamping within a 48 hour period.
