2. I consent and agree to comply with and be bound by all of the provisions of the FEI and BEF Anti-Doping Rules, including but not limited to, all amendments to the Anti-Doping Rules and all International Standards incorporated in the Anti-Doping Rules.
3. I acknowledge and agree that the British Showjumping, the BEF and the FEI have jurisdiction to impose sanctions as provided in the FEI and BEF Anti-Doping Rules.
4. I also acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the BEF Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the BEF Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article 13 of the BEF Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes, is the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
5. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the arbitral appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.

## FEI RIDER REGISTRATION APPLICATION



1. As from 1st January 2006, riders wishing to compete at International Shows (under FEI Rules), whether in Britain or overseas, **MUST** be registered with the FEI, via the British Showjumping.
2. It is imperative that you read and familiarise yourself with the BEF Rule Book which contains all up to date anti doping regulations. This can be downloaded from the BEF website ([www.bef.co.uk](http://www.bef.co.uk)). Alternatively it can be e-mailed or sent to you by post on request from the British Showjumping International Office.
3. Once you have read the BEF Rule Book, please sign and return the attached acknowledgement and agreement form for the anti-doping rules. Under the new regulations we cannot issue your FEI Registration unless we are in receipt of your signed acknowledgement and agreement form.
4. Riders in possession of an FEI Registration who are using any form of medication need to check the UK Sport Drug Information Database ([www.ukspor.gov.uk/did](http://www.ukspor.gov.uk/did)) to see whether they are required to submit a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). If after checking the UK Sport website you are still unsure, please contact the BEF Chief Medical Advisor, Dr Peter Whitehead, for further information (e-mail: [whiteheadpn@doctors.org.uk](mailto:whiteheadpn@doctors.org.uk), telephone: 01452 713038 mobile: 07768497756).
5. Ensure the appropriate payment is enclosed with your application. Cheques made payable to the British Showjumping.
6. The cost of registration for 2010 is:
  - £15.00 PER RIDER
7. Please note that rider registration expires on 31st December of that year and is therefore renewable for each calendar year.
8. **ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO ENTRY.** FEI Registration numbers will be produced on the FEI web site every Wednesday morning. **It is your responsibility to ensure that you are registered prior to entry at an FEI Competition.**
9. **PLEASE REMEMBER THAT IF YOU ARE NOT FEI REGISTERED YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE POINTS TOWARDS THE FEI WORLD RANKING LIST.** Unregistered riders will be stopped from competing in International competitions.
