Reporting of Incidents & Accidents

To help with any resulting investigations and paperwork, British Showjumping Officials are asked to inform British Showjumping HQ of any Incidents / Accidents that occur within the Competition Arena as soon as possible after the show has completed.

The <u>Accident Report Form</u> can be submitted by email or with the results however notification of these Incidents / Accidents needs to arrive at British Showjumping HQ no later than 48 hours (excluding Sunday) after the incident has occurred.

Judging Sheets

Judges are kindly reminded to ensure that the triplicate copies of the Judging and Results Sheets from any show where they are judging at are distributed to following parties below: -

White Copy - To be sent to British Showjumping HQ in the pre paid envelopes (Stoneleigh Addressed Envelopes are still valid)

Yellow Copy - To be given to the Show Organiser

Pink Copy - To be retained by the Judge signing the sheets for a period of 6 months

This is to ensure British Showjumping can request the other copies of the results sheets should anything happen to the White Copy.

Winter Grand Prix - Rule 501

Due to an administration error in the 2013 Members Handbook, the table under which a Winter Grand Prix runs is incorrect. This is incorrectly listed on Page 191 where the rule is listed in Section 4 of the Handbook, and on Page 180, the Course Specification

The correct table for this competition is Table A10, and not Table A7 as listed.

All Officials are requested to ensure that all scheduled Winter Grand Prix's run as per Table A10 rules (Rule 192E).
