Coaching Approach

During lessons I address why issues arise and give my clients the tools to continue understanding their horses in a variety of circumstances.

I believe that all lessons should be a positive experience for both horse/pony rider and by the end of the lesson they have usually exceeded their own expectations.

Coaching Experience

I am a professional full time Showjumping Coach. For the past 30years I have regularly taught a variety of individuals and groups including British Showjumping members, Pony and Riding Clubs. In 2005 I became a British Showjumping Accredited Coach and in 2008 a UKCC coach Educator.

I have experience coaching all ages, levels and types of horses which compete in various disciplines including Showjumping, Eventing, dressage and racing.

I specialise in giving confidence to young, novice and nervous horse/riders.

Riding Experience

I have jumped international trials and the Queen Elizabeth cup. I have ridden all my life and as a Junior I was shortlisted for Junior Europeans Event Team, As a senior I have specialised in Showjumping and I have always produced my own horses and have won the Young horse Final twice. Further I was second in the Grade A final at HOYS and have qualified for the Foxhunter finals 3 times.

Other

I run a small yard focused on Showjumping and training, it has some competition liveries. I also cater for short or long term Showjumping courses (with and without riders) I have turnout and a walker.

The loose jumping facilities are very usual aids both for the horse/pony and rider.

I teach both at Forest Farm and will travel.

I often see and support my clients and pupils while they are competing and at shows.
