In 1980, at the age of twenty he became the youngest rider to win the Hickstead Derby and there has been little stopping him ever since. Competing at four Olympic Games he won Team Silver in 1984 in Atlanta. In addition he has won four World Championship medals, fourteen European Championship medals in addition to winning prestigious titles such as the King George V Gold Cup, World Cups, Grand Prix's and of course the Hickstead Derby which he has won a total of four times.

His most recent medal win was in 2013 when he won Team Gold at the European Championships with Viking V, a horse he has taken time to produce slowly having focused him on the World Cup circuit during the winter before.

Globally recognised as an empathic rider who can give confidence to the most nervous or difficult of horses, Michael is a name that frequently comes up as the 'one rider' which others hold in the highest esteem. A family man through and through he takes great pride in his children's sporting successes and is frequently seen supporting them at pony shows throughout the country.
