Career Summary: Ben started riding after his mother introduced him to ponies and he joined

the local pony club. Winning two Pony European Gold medals for Great Britain before moving onto horses it wasn't long before Ben was having considerable success on the International stage at a senior level. In 2005 he won the Hickstead Derby and the Speed Derby with Alfredo after which he continued competing successfully across Europe. His big break came however when he was selected for the Beijing Olympics with Rolette. Since then Ben has also gone on to represent Great Britain at two European Championships, the most recent being in 2011 at Madrid where he played a

major role in securing a Team Bronze.
