#### HOW TO QUALIFY FOR THE SEMI-FINALS

If hoping to qualify via the Regional League route, qualification will be based on points gained between 1st April - 30th June in the current calendar year.

If via the direct qualifiers, the semi final venue will be allocated in line with those qualifying via the leagues ie by Members Area.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SEMI-FINALS

- · The Semi-Final will run under Table A8
- Three rounds of heights 1.05m-1.10m-1.15m
- The Final will run Table A10 and a 1st round height of 1.10m

### 8 DIRECT QUALIFIERS

from which three combinations qualify

#### LEAGUE POINTS TABLE

Placing	85cm-1.10r
1st	10 points
2nd	8 points
3rd	6 points
4th	4 points
5th	3 points
6th	2 points
Double Clears	5 points

#### REMEMBER -

- Four direct qualifiers can be contested per horse/rider combination.
- Three combinations per direct qualifier will go through to the semi finals.
- Competitiors will be permitted to attend any four qualifiers for the semi finals and are not restricted to North or South.
- For the semi finals members will have to compete in the appropriate North/South semi final as defined by their registered postal address.
