To apply for the Level 2 Judge Assessment, this logbook must be completed to evidence that you have demonstrated each of the competencies to the level required to upgrade. It is a requirement to attend a minimum of 12 shows and judge with a Level 3 Judge for a minimum of 2 days before applying for upgrade to Level 2 Judge status.

Each section can be signed off by a Level 2 or Level 3 Judge who you have worked with at the show. Guidance for Judges signing off logbooks can be found at the end of the logbook.

Officials who have endorsed the experience gained in this logbook may be contacted, in addition to the Regional Development Officer and Regional Mentor for the Judge's area.

If all the requirements have been completed then you will be able to apply for the Level 2 Judge Assessment.

Once appointed as a British Showjumping Level 2 Judge, the following retention criteria apply

- Officiate at a minimum of 6 show days per year
- Attend an Officials Training Conference once every two years
- Hold a current certificate in the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults
- Hold a current British Showjumping membership

Guidance for Judges signing off the Logbook

- Only Level 2 or Level 3 Judges can sign off competencies in the Level 2 Judge Logbook
- Sections can be signed off when the Level 2 Judge has demonstrated competency in the area as set out in the Judge Competencies.
- You may be contacted by British Showjumping to confirm that the information provided is accurate
- The Feedback section is to be used to highlight strengths or record any comments which can support the Level 2 Judge to develop further.
