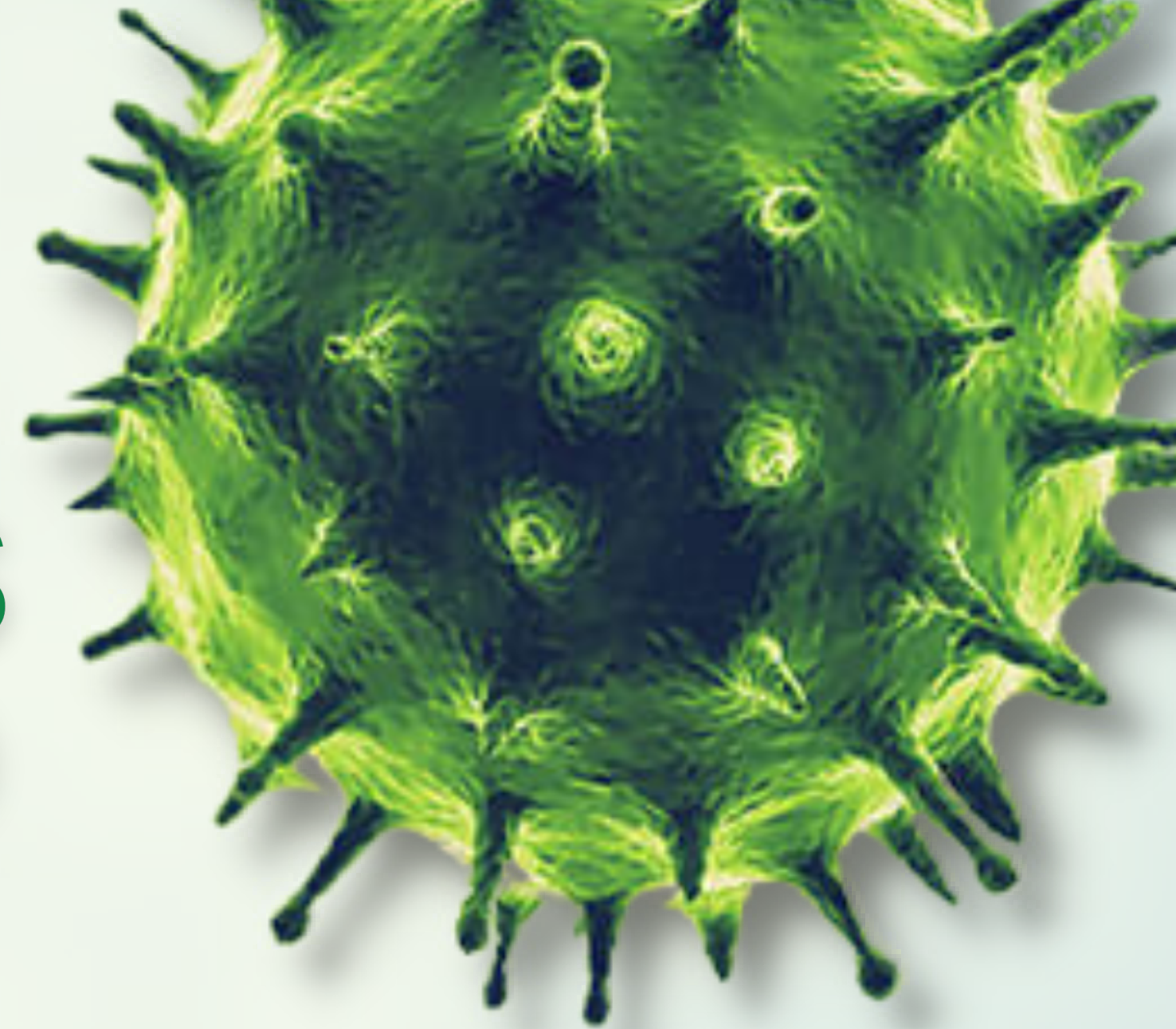

What is EHV?



EHV stands for Equid alphaHerpes Virus.



The two most common strains are EHV1 and EHV4.

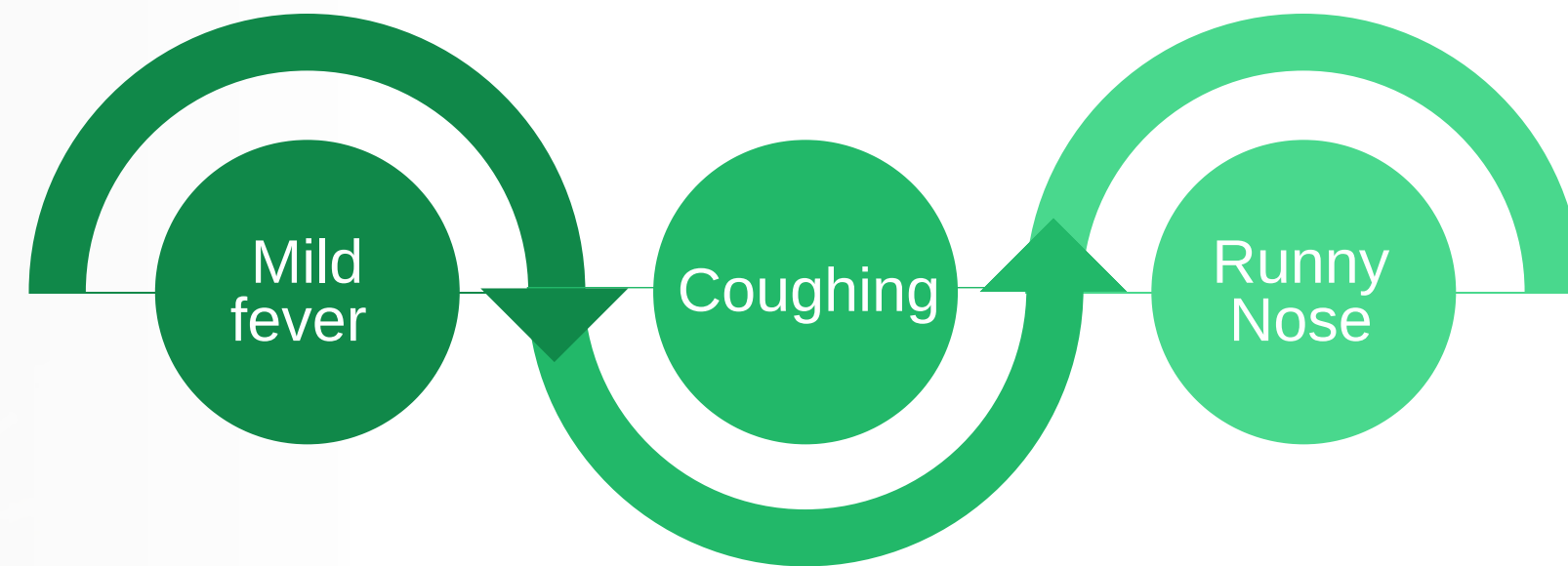
EHV is a silent killer – it can lay dormant for years.



Horses can be carriers of the disease while displaying NO clinical signs.

What are the **SIGNS** to look for?

Typically, the onset of signs will be in response to a stress event – post travel or competition – or when the horse has become immuno-suppressed.



Signs of **RESPIRATORY** Disease



Signs of **NEUROLOGICAL** Disease

These may be preceded by respiratory signs.

How does EHV SPREAD?

AIR

The virus is most commonly transmitted via nasal secretions, both airborne infectious particles from nasal discharge and coughing within a 20ft distance.

SURFACE

EHV can remain infectious for **up to 7 days** on wood, paper and leather but **up to 35 days** on fabric, horse mane and tail hair – those swishing tails transfer particles into the atmosphere.

WATER

Contaminated Fomites – clothing, equipment, transport, grooming tools, feed, bedding, buckets, even water itself – can transfer the virus onto a new host.

If a horse presents with signs of EHV, you should:



Immediately isolate the horse



Call your vet



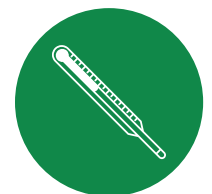
Close the yard to all horse movements



Monitor all horses on the yard for symptoms



Disinfect your boots and change your clothing



Monitor horses for symptoms

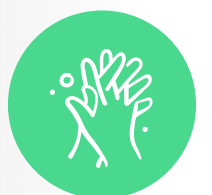


Provide each horse with their own equipment

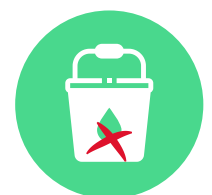


Keep up to date with vaccinations

Preventative Measures



Have visitors to your yard wash their hands



Don't share water sources away from your yard



Prevent contact with unfamiliar horses off the yard



Clean & disinfect equipment and transport after events
