Career Summary: Ben started riding after his mother Leslie introduced him to ponies. He was a member of the local pony club and he had a go at everything but it was obvious his love was Showjumping. Training from Steven Smith saw Ben win 2 pony European gold medals. Serving his apprenticeship at Ted and Liz Edgar's yard Ben then moved to Switzerland where he trained with international show jumper Beat Mandli. Once returning to England and setting he set up his own yard he went on to win both the Hickstead Derby and the Speed Derby in 2005. Then 2008 came his big break where he was selected for the Bejing Olympics. Since then Ben has gone on the represent Great Britain at 2 European Championships the most resent being Madrid in 2011 where he brought home Team Silver. Ben has also gone onto win many top National and International classes.
